High Point Housing Authority Announces New Chief Executive Officer

High Point, NC – The Housing Authority of the City of High Point (HPHA) looks certain to have a new Chief Executive Officer as early as November 01. During the past month, the Board of Commissioners held two closed session meetings in order to interview numerous candidates for the CEO position that became vacant on May 31, 2010, when Robert L. Kenner's resignation became effective.

The Board met again today, 09/22/10, in a special meeting to vote on the contract for a new Chief Executive Officer. After the official vote today, a two-year contract will be offered to Angela Grace McGill to fill the position of HPHA's CEO.

In 2003, Ms. McGill began her career with the High Point Housing Authority as the Executive Assistant to Executive Director. From this position she moved up to Director Compliance/Executive Assistant, Vice President Compliance/Quality Control, Vice President Compliance/Quality Control/Asset Management/Operations/Section 8, and finally to the position of Chief Operating Officer in January 2009. This was the position she held with the HPHA until her resignation in December 2009 to accept the position of Executive Director with the Rockingham Housing Authority in Rockingham, NC, her current position.

Ms. McGill has served on various commissions and boards which include the City of High Point Human Relations Commission, Chair; Total Family Focus Board, Vice Chair; YWCA of Greater High Point, Board member; High Point University Alumni, Board member; American Red Cross High Point-Thomasville Chapter, Board member. She also serves on the Carolina Council of Code and Redevelopment Officials (CCHRCO) Commissioners Support Services & Commissioner Conference Committee.

She is a recipient of the *2009 Business Woman Extraordinaire of High Point, NC* and *Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities* and graduated from Leadership High Point, City Government 101, and is a member of *National Association of Female Executives*. She received her high school diploma in Gainesville, Florida, certification from Brookstone College and served in the U.S. Army prior to attending High Point University where she received both her Bachelor of Science degree and MBA in Business Administration.

She is the mother of three children, Dymaan Flores, Daniel Flores, and Maya McGill, and the grandmother of two granddaughters, Tatiyana Flores and Angelina Flores.

Ms. McGill will officially begin her duties as CEO on November 01, 2010.
